1. UNDER SKIN
2. BRUISE

MINOR---COLD CONTROL (ICEPACK)

SERIOUS-----INTERNAL BLEEDING

B. OPEN

1. INFECTION
2. DIRECT PRESSURE *****
3. COVER WOUND WITH CLEAN/STERILE DRESSING
4. MINIMIZE SHOCK
5. IMPALED OBJECT—LEAVE IN AND WRAP AROUND

2. WOUNDS: BURN INJURIES

A. SOURCE:

1. THERMAL—(MOST COMMON)
2. TOXIC CHEMICALS
3. ELECTRICITY
4. RADIATION

B. DEPTH:

1. SURFACE AREA 1ST
2. BLISTER 2ND
3. DOWN TO BONE 3RD

FIRST AID FOR BURNS:

- A. COOL AND COVER WITH STERILE DRESSING
- B. WRAP LOOSELY
